**Jesus Glorified God By His Submission to God (12:27-30)**

- Feel the Son's \_\_\_\_\_.
  - Jesus submits to the Father's \_\_\_\_\_. (27)
  - Jesus seeks the Father's \_\_\_\_\_. (28)
- Hear the Father's \_\_\_\_\_.
  - *"I have glorified it."*
  - *"I will glorify it again."*
    - Jesus has come to make God look \_\_\_\_\_ in salvation.
    - Jesus has come to make man \_\_\_\_\_ in God.

**Jesus Glorified God Through His Suffering on the Cross (12:31-33)**

- Reflect on the world's \_\_\_\_\_.
  - Jesus is the light who comes into the world to divide...
    - Some will have their evil deeds exposed...
      - Unrepentant sinners will be \_\_\_\_\_.
    - Others will embrace the light. (John 3:19-21)
      - Repentant saints will be \_\_\_\_\_.
  - This is the glorious mystery of the cross:
    - Bad judgment: Sinners showed themselves to be \_\_\_\_\_.
    - Good judgment: God showed himself to be \_\_\_\_\_.
- Rejoice in the Son's \_\_\_\_\_.
  - "Lifted up" has two meanings:
    - He will be \_\_\_\_\_ on a cross. (John 12:33)

      - Satan has been publicly disarmed. (Col. 2:13-15)
      - Satan will be eternally dismissed. (Revelation 20:10)
