### **Expository Preaching: What Is It?**

- An expositional sermon takes the main point of a passage of **Scripture**, makes it the main point of the **sermon**, and applies it to life today.
- Expository sermons seek to "expose" people to what God says in His Word.

#### Where Is It In the Bible?

- Levitical priests taught the law. (Deuteronomy 33:10)
- Ezra and the Levites read from the law and gave the sense of it. (Nehemiah 8:8)
- Peter & the apostles expounded Scripture, urging their hearers to repent and believe. (Acts 2)
- God condemns prophets who speak "from their own imaginations, not from the mouth of the Lord." (Jer. 23:16; 18, 21-22)

## Why Is It Important?

- If we get this one right, everything else will <u>follow</u>.
- If we get this one wrong, everything else will **fail**.

### I. God's People Were Created by God's Word

- Genesis 1- God **speaks** to create the world.
- Genesis 3- After the Fall, God gives Adam and Eve a word of hope.
- Genesis 12- God calls Abram to follow him through a promise.
- Exodus 3- God speaks to Moses through a burning bush.
- Exodus 20- God gives his people his word through the <u>Law</u>.
- 1 Kings 18- The "word of the Lord" came to Elijah to go speak to Ahab.
- Ezekiel 37- God commanded Ezekiel to preach to dead bones to give them life.
- Mark 7- Jesus speaks to a **deaf** man in order that his ears would be opened.
- John 1- Jesus comes as the Incarnate Word of God in the flesh.
- Romans 10:17- Faith comes by <u>hearing</u> the word of Christ.
