The Big Question: Are We Willing to Follow God's Plan for Ordering the Church?

- We should not be **embarrassed** by what the Scriptures teach.
- As Christians, we must **embrace** all of what the Scriptures say.

 - Do not draw attention to physical beauty.
 - Do not draw attention to <u>worldly</u> wealth.
- Adore God through a **Christlike** demeanor. (10)

III. Paul Clarifies the Distinctive Roles of Men and Women in the Church (2:11-15)

- Paul gives two prohibitions for women in corporate worship. (11-12)
 - Silence- Women should not **teach** as elders/pastors in the church.
 - Women should listen willingly to the biblical instruction of elders.
 - Women should teach in various settings of the church in accord with elder instruction.
 - Submission- Women should not <u>lead</u> as elders/pastors in the church.
 - Women submit gladly to the servant leadership of elders.
 - Women should lead in various positions of the church under the authority of elders.

 - God created men and women with equal value.
 - God created men and women with complementary <u>roles</u>...

 - In the **church**.

 - #1- God's **design** in creation: God gives authority to man. (13)
 - o #2- Satan's distortion of creation: Man abdicates authority and woman assumes it. (14)

 - Women are **sanctified** as they glorify God in the distinct roles He has entrusted to them.
 - Women are **saved** not through the birth of a child but through the death of Christ.
