Two Roles of Deacons

- Deacons are **servants**.
- Deacons are **shock** absorbers.

Three Responsibilities of Deacons (Acts 6:1-7)

- Deacons <u>meet needs</u> according to the Word.
 - They arise from specific circumstances.
 - They assume accountability for specific commands.
- Deacons **support** the ministry of the Word.
 - o Deacons serve elders so they can lead.
 - o Deacons <u>lead</u> others so they can serve.
- Deacons <u>unify</u> the body around the Word.
 - Deacons demonstrate a <u>Christlike</u> character with a <u>mission</u> mindset.

Eight Requirements for Deacons (3:8-13)

- Dignified- Is he honorable and worthy of respect? (8)
- Not Double-Tongued- Is he a hypocrite or insincere? (8)
- Not Addicted to Much Wine- Is he self-controlled or is he consumed with drinking? (8)
- Not Greedy for Dishonest Gain- Is he a lover of ministry or a lover of money? (8)
- Sound in Faith and Life- Does he have a firm grasp on the gospel, and does he live it out? (9)
- Blameless- Has he been tested and proven to be above reproach? (10)
- Faithful to His Wife- Is he wholly devoted both physically and emotionally to his wife alone? (12)
- Manage Children and Household Well- Does he spiritually lead his family well? (12)
- What about women? (v. 11)

The Rewards of a Deacon (3:13)

- Respect: They receive **good** standing in the church.
- Boldness: They receive **great** confidence in the faith.
- The work of a deacon is not glamorous, but the rewards are **glorious**.
