## "A Misunderstood Missionary"

## **ONE BIG QUESTION:**

- Do we as a church consider the people we are trying to reach as more important than <u>ourselves</u>?
  - o Are we so hopeful that God will work in the future that we are willing to be **uncomfortable** today?
  - o Are we willing to say, "This is not about <u>us?</u>"
  - o Are we willing to be misunderstood for the sake of reaching lost people?

## A Misunderstood Missionary

- Paul was misunderstood in his **mission**. (21:1-16)
  - o His Christian friends tried to **protect** him from danger.
  - o Paul was relentless in his **pursuit** of Jesus, in spite of danger.
- Paul was misunderstood in his **ministry**. (21:17-40)
  - o The elders in Jerusalem heard about Paul's work among the Gentiles and <u>rejoiced</u>.
  - o The elders then express concern about Paul's teachings to the Jews that were based on **rumors**.
    - Some thought Paul was teaching <u>Jews</u> they should no longer follow the OT law.
    - Paul had only taught **Gentiles** that they were not required to keep the OT law.
      - God's grace gave the Gentiles freedom to **abstain** from the law.
      - God's grace gave the Jews freedom to **observe** the law.
  - o The elders ask Paul to publicly display his unity with the Jewish church by performing a vow.
    - Question: Why would Paul go through with it?
      - Paul loved the <u>Jewish</u> nation. (Romans 9:1)
      - Paul loved the **lost**. (1 Cor. 9:19-22)
      - Paul desired <u>unity</u> within the church.
      - Paul desired **peace** between Jews and Gentiles.
    - Question: Did Paul compromise the gospel?
      - Though some may question Paul's judgment, the motive of his heart was **pure**.
      - Paul was trying to become all things to all men in order to save **some**.
      - Paul acted out of **love** by trying to avoid being offensive to his Jewish brothers.
  - o Paul is arrested after some Jews assume he brought a Gentile into the inner courts of the temple.
    - Just like Jesus, Paul was falsely accused.
    - Just like Jesus, Paul was wrongfully <u>arrested</u>.

	o He told about his former (v. 1-5)
	<ul> <li>When you share your testimony, tell about your past without glorifying your</li> </ul>
	o He told about his miraculous (v. 6-16)
	<ul> <li>When you share your testimony, make it more about than about</li> </ul>
	o He told about his special (v. 17-21)
	<ul> <li>When you share your testimony, elevate God's purpose of in the gospel.</li> </ul>
1	What are the 4 main parts of the Gospel?  o He is our holy Creator and righteous judge. He created us to glorify and enjoy Him forever.  o We have all rebelled against God by sinning against his law, and we deserve his wrath.  o Jesus, fully God and fully man, died the death we deserved and was raised from the dead.  o We must repent of our sins and believe in Jesus Christ for forgiveness of our sins.
