God's Trusted Servant: The Righteous Branch (33:15-18)

- He will reign as a king from David's line.
 - He is the **rightful** king.
 - He is the **righteous** king.
- He will serve as a <u>priest</u> like the tribe of Levi.
 - He will serve the people humbly.
 - He will make his people **holy**.
