## **Asking the Right Questions:**

- The wrong question: What did I get out of worship today?
- The right question: Was <u>God</u> pleased with my worship today?
- The question is not IF we will worship, but rather HOW and WHO we will worship.

### I. <u>Preparation</u>: What We Should Do BEFORE Worship (5:1)

- We must not be **casual** in our worship.
  - o If you treat God lightly, you fail to honor him as holy.
  - o If you approach God rightly, you will come to him **humbly**.
- We must be **slow** to speak and **quick** to listen.
  - We pay attention to the <u>word</u> of God as it is read and preached.
  - We submit to obey the <u>will</u> of God as it is revealed in Scripture.
    - A faithful worshiper goes to church to hear God.
    - A foolish worshiper goes to church to hear <u>himself</u>.
    - You need to hear from God more than God needs to hear from you.

## II. <u>Participation</u>: How We Should Act DURING Worship (5:2-3)

- We dare not be careless with our words.
  - We must avoid using empty words. (2)
  - We must avoid using **many** words. (3)
    - A busy mind races with many dreams, and a fool's mouth runs with many words.
      - Don't let your **tongue** outrun your brain.
      - Don't let your **heart** rush you into words.
- We must be <u>careful</u> with our words.
  - Remember who you are speaking to.
    - You are speaking to the holy God in **heaven**.
  - Remember who you are.
    - You are a sinful human on earth.
  - o Therefore, let your words be **few**.

### III. Practice: How We Should Live AFTER Worship (5:4-7)

- We must be **committed** in our walk.
  - All true worship involves making commitments to God in response to His word.
  - A vow was a special promise made by a worshiper in response to answered prayers.
  - Some tried to avoid paying the vow after God had answered their prayer.
  - Their mouths led them into sin. God does not take careless vows lightly.
    - Careless vows bring God's <u>anger</u> on our words.
    - Careless vows bring God's judgment on our works.
- When you come to worship God:
  - o Think before you speak.
  - Say what you mean.
  - <u>Do</u> what you <u>say</u>.
- Casual worship, careless words, and empty promises produce worship that is foolish.
- True worship begins with <u>fearing</u> God.
