Ecclesiastes 7:15-29

A Universal Problem: The Sin of Injustice in a Puzzling World (7:15)

- The righteous do not always prosper, and sometimes they die **early**.
- The wicked do not always suffer, and sometimes they live <u>long</u>.

Warning #1: The Sin of Imbalance: Avoid Unbiblical Extremes of Wickedness and Foolishness (7:16-19)

- Don't be super-righteous. (16)
 - This is the danger of legalism.
 - Self-righteous people pretend to be more than they really are.
- Don't be super-wicked. (17)
 - This is the danger of moral **indifference**.
 - Wicked people do not care about what is right.
- We avoid both dangers by **fearing** God. (18)
 - A balanced person doesn't think too **much** of themselves.
 - o A balanced person doesn't think too **little** of sin.
- Wisdom does have its place. (19)

The Universal Truth: There is No One Righteous (7:20)

- Every <u>person</u> has sinned and fallen short of the glory of God.
 - There is no one who **always** does what is right.
 - There is no one who **never** does wrong.
- Every part of us has been corrupted by sin.

Warning #2: The Sin of the Tongue: Avoid Being Oversensitive at Others' Words (7:21-22)

- You may sometimes hear people say bad things about <u>you</u>. (21)
- Don't get too upset, because you have said things that were unkind about others. (22)

The Universal Search: There Are Some Questions Wisdom Cannot Answer (7:23-25)

- Wisdom is necessary for living a life pleasing to God.
- However, no amount of wisdom will allow you to fully grasp all God's plans and purposes.
 - More wisdom won't help you comprehend the universe.
 - More wisdom won't help you <u>control</u> the universe.

Warning #3: The Sin of Sexual Immorality: Avoid the Seductive Woman (7:26)

- The sinner willingly falls into the trap of sexual temptation.
 - The Bible never commands believers to <u>fight</u> sexual sin.
 - The Bible always commands believers to <u>flee</u> sexual sin.
- The person who seeks to please God will avoid the seductive, empty promises of sexual temptation.
 - This warning is not meant to deny something **pleasant**.
 - This warning is meant to protect something **precious**.

The Universal Conclusion: Sinful People Are Hard to Figure Out (7:27-29)

- Both men and women are difficult to understand. (27-28)
- Even though God made mankind upright, we have all gone astray. (29)
 - Because of the Fall, everyone in Adam <u>sins</u>.
 - Because of the Cross, everyone in Christ will be <u>saved</u>.
