John 1:29-34

## Behold the Lamb because he is the only one who removes sin. (1:29)

- He is the **sinless** lamb given by God.
- He is the lamb who takes away sin.
- He takes away the sin of the world.

## Behold the Lamb because he is the only one who gives the Spirit. (1:30-33)

- What does Jesus' baptism in the Holy Spirit mean?
  - The Holy Spirit comes through **Jesus**. (John 15:26)
  - Jesus immerses people in the Spirit.
  - Baptism signifies all that the Spirit does for us.
- What effect will the Spirit have in our lives?
  - The Holy Spirit gives new **life** by causing the new birth. (John 6:63)
  - The Holy Spirit not only makes us life-getters, but life-givers. (John 7:38-39)
  - The Holy Spirit witnesses to Jesus. (John 15:26)
  - The Holy Spirit **glorifies** Jesus. (John 16:14)

## Behold the Lamb because he is the only one worthy of worship as God's risen Son. (1:34)

- The Lion of Judah became our sacrificial lamb.
- The Lamb of God is now a conquering **lion**.
- The Lion and Lamb will forever be worshiped as the risen **Lord**. (Rev. 5:8-9)
