The Pattern of Discipleship...

- Christians are **chosen** by Jesus to follow Him.
- Christians are being **changed** by Jesus.
- Christians are calling others to Jesus.

Jesus Calls His Disciples...

Jesus can command our allegiance. (1:43-44)

- Jesus shows his authority by commanding people to follow him.
- When we choose to follow Jesus, we will realize that he chose us **first**. (John 15:16)

Jesus knows us inside and out. (1:45-48)

- Jesus knows our circumstances.
 - He knew Nathaniel on the **outside**. *"When you were under the fig tree, I saw you."*
 - You will never be in a situation where Jesus is not fully aware of what's going on in your life.
- Jesus knows our **hearts**.
 - He knew Nathaniel on the **inside**. *"Here is a man in whom is no deceit!"*
 - Jesus' supernatural knowledge of Nathaniel removed all doubt that he was truly the Son of God.

Jesus is the only way to reach the Father. (1:49-51)

- In Genesis, Jacob dreamed of a ladder where angels ascended and descended to Heaven. (Gen. 28)
- In John, Jesus replaces the ladder with **himself** as the only way for us to reach God. (John 14:6)
 - Jesus is the decisive, final connection between heaven and earth.
 - Jesus is the place where people now meet **God**.
