John 10:1-10

**Jesus Gathers His Sheep (9:1-6)**

- False shepherds refuse to use the door.
  - A thief is \_\_\_\_\_.
  - A robber is \_\_\_\_\_.
  - The Pharisees were \_\_\_\_\_.
- The true shepherd leads his sheep through the door.
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ each sheep intimately.
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ each sheep individually.
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ each sheep irresistibly.
  - He \_\_\_\_\_ each sheep invincibly.
- The Good Shepherd is the door!
  - The sheep will \_\_\_\_\_ from false shepherds.
  - The sheep will \_\_\_\_\_ the Good Shepherd.

**Jesus Guards His Sheep (9:7-10)**

- As the Door, Jesus is the only way we can become part of the people of God. (John 14:6)
- As the Door, Jesus makes two promises to those who come to the Father through him:
  - He promises them \_\_\_\_\_. *"He will be saved."*
    - This is solid \_\_\_\_\_.
  - He promises them \_\_\_\_\_. *"He will go in and out and find pasture."*
    - This is soul \_\_\_\_\_.
- As the Door, Jesus promises that his sheep will have abundant life.
  - "Abundant life" does not mean that we will have more \_\_\_\_\_.
  - "Abundant life" means we have peace and joy because we have \_\_\_\_\_. (Ez. 34:11-16)

**Jesus Gives His Life for the Sheep (9:11-21)**
