So Many Witnesses... Who is on Trial?

- Jesus was not being put on trial by the world.
- The world is being put on trial by <u>Jesus</u>.
 - Jesus is not speaking in this passage as a <u>defendant</u>.
 - Jesus is speaking as the <u>prosecutor</u>.
- Who is on trial here?
 - We are.
 - The Big Question: What are you going to believe about Jesus?

The Witnesses of Christ Condemn Those Who Do Not Believe

- The Witness of Jesus (31-32)
- The Witness of John the Baptist (33-35)
 - John came as a witness to prepare the way for Jesus.
 - John did not testify for Jesus' sake.
 - John testified for <u>our</u> sake.
 - John came as a lamp to <u>point</u> the way to Jesus.
 - John was <u>a</u> lamp but...
 - He was not **the** light.
- The Witness of Jesus' Works (36)
 - o Jesus' works are greater than John's words.
 - From the manger to the empty tomb, all Jesus' works proved that Jesus was **God**.
 - o If you won't believe what Jesus said, you should believe because of what Jesus has done.
- The Witness of the Father (37-38)
 - The most forceful witness to the truth about Jesus comes from the Father.
 - The Father testified at Jesus' **baptism**. (Matthew 3:17)
 - The Father testified at Jesus' transfiguration. (Matthew 17:5)
 - However, the Jews did not receive the Father's testimony because they had rejected Jesus.
 - How could they hear his voice? Through **Jesus**.
 - Jesus speaks with the **voice** of God. (John 3:34)
 - How could they see his form? Through <u>Jesus</u>.
 - Jesus is the perfect **image** of God. (Colossians 1:15; John 1:18)
 - How could they receive his word? Through <u>Jesus</u>.
 - Jesus is the incarnate **word** of God. (Hebrews 1:1-3; 2 John 9)
- The Witness of the Scripture (39-47)
 - Studying the Scriptures does not give eternal life. The Scriptures point to the One who gives life.
 - Legalism says "do!"
 - The Gospel proclaims "done!"
 - The Pharisees had a craving for human praise that kept them from coming to Christ.
 - You cannot claim to love God and **reject** Jesus.
 - You cannot gain the approval of God while seeking the **applause** of men.
 - At the root of unbelief is a love for human **praise**.
 - **Pride** will keep you out of the kingdom of God.
 - If you reject the Bible as God's word, then you will reject God's Son whom the Bible reveals.
