Desertion: Many Disciples Left Jesus. (6:60-66)

- Not every disciple is a **true** disciple. (60-62)
 - o False disciples come to Jesus for reasons other than **Jesus**.
 - o False disciples **stumble** over Jesus words rather than submit to them.
 - o False disciples will eventually find some reason to fall away and stop believing. (1 John 2:19)
- Only the <u>Spirit</u> can produce a true disciple. (63-65)
 - Our flesh cannot help us.
 - Jesus gives life by his word.
 - Our faith is a <u>gift</u> from God.
- You can be a disciple and not a Christian, but you cannot be a Christian and not a **disciple**. (66)

Devotion: A Few of the Disciples Remained with Jesus. (6:67-69)

- True disciples make a **commitment** to follow Jesus.
 - o If we have Christ, we have everything.
 - o If we do not have Christ, we have **nothing**.
- True disciples make a **confession** of faith in Jesus.
 - You have to know who Jesus is.
 - You have to trust Jesus completely.

Deception: One of the Disciples Betrayed Jesus (6:70-71)

- This chapter ends with apparent failure.
 - The big question: Is the devil winning?
 - o The clear answer: No. The devil is doing whatever God intends him to do.
 - The **devil** is not in charge.
