#### Where Do You Stand With Jesus?

John 7:25-31

#### The Confusion of the Crowd (7:25-27)

- See the <u>Fearless</u> courage of Jesus.
  - Until God is finished with you, you are <u>immortal</u>.
  - When God is finished with you, will will be eternal.
- See the Faulty conclusions of the Jews.
- Big Question #1: Who do you say Jesus is?

#### The Claim of Christ (7:28-29)

- Jesus **speaks** for the Father.
  - If you reject Jesus, you reject <u>God</u>.
  - o If you reject Jesus as God's Son, it means...
    - You do not **know** God. (John 8:19)
    - You do not **honor** God. (John 5:23)
    - You do not **love** God. (John 5:42-43)
    - You do not have God as your **Father**. (John 8:42)
- Jesus was **sent** by the Father.
  - Only Jesus truly <u>knows</u> the Father.
  - Only Jesus can make the Father <u>known</u>.
- Big Question #2: Where do you think Jesus came from?

### The Conversion of Christians (7:30-31)

- Christ always divides people.
  - Jesus is the most loved man who ever lived.
  - o Jesus is the most **hated** man who ever lived.
- Christ is able to **deliver** believers.
  - o Allegiance to Jesus will mean alienation from the world.
  - o Faith in Jesus will mean **freedom** from the world.
- Big Question #3: What will you do with Jesus?

"I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God." That is the one thing we must not say. A man who said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic—on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg—or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse. You can shut Him up for a fool, you can spit at Him and kill Him as a demon; or you can fall at His feet and call Him Lord and God. But let us not come with any patronizing nonsense about His being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to."
