 - $\circ~$ As the light, Jesus is the **<u>Savior</u>**. (Isaiah 49:6)
 - As the light, Jesus is **<u>God</u>**. (1 John 1:5; Psalm 27:1)
 - As the light, Jesus is the **Judge**. (John 3:19-20)
- Notice the consequences of Jesus being the light:
 - There is no other light for the world other than Jesus. It is either Jesus or **<u>darkness</u>**. (John 1:4-5)
 - **Everyone** in the world needs Jesus as their light. (John 12:35, 46)
 - Creation was made for this light. It exposes the ugliness of sin and the beauty of everything good.
 - One day the world will be filled with this light. Darkness will be cast out, and Jesus' glory will shine.

The Clash: The Pharisees Illustrate Walking in Spiritual Darkness (8:13-19)

- If you walk in darkness, you will resist the truth. (13)
- If you walk in darkness, you will remain **blind** to Christ. (14)
- If you walk in darkness, you will refuse sound judgment. (15-18)
- If you walk in darkness, you will reject the **Father**. (19)
 - Jesus reveals the Father- To know Jesus is to know the Father. (John 5:23)
 - Jesus speaks <u>from</u> God. He is the light of the world because he comes from the Father.
 - Jesus speaks <u>for</u> God. He is the light of the world because he speaks for the Father.
 - Jesus speaks <u>as</u> God. He is the light of the world because he is one with the Father.
 - The Father reveals Jesus- No one can know Jesus apart from the Father's drawing. (John 6:44-45)

The Conclusion: The Pharisees Remain in Darkness, Jesus Is Not Arrested (8:20)

- The hour of Jesus' death had not yet come.
 - Jesus would **<u>enter</u>** the darkness of our sin by his crucifixion.
 - Jesus would **<u>expel</u>** the darkness of death through his resurrection.
 - Jesus would be **<u>exalted</u>** over the darkness as Lord of life through his ascension.
- The hour of **your** death is coming.
 - Follow Christ, and no longer walk in darkness.
 - Come to the light, and receive true life.
