A Generation Arises That Does Not Know the Lord (2:6-10)

- Lack of discipleship causes spiritual <u>drifting</u>.
 - We not only want our children to **learn** about the Lord.
 - We pray our children will know and <u>love</u> the Lord.
- Amnesia leads to apostasy.
 - When you forget the Lord you will **forsake** the Lord.

The Cycle of Sin and Redemption: Depravity and Deliverance (2:11-23)

- One God over Israel...
 - They illustrated man's **depravity**.
 - The core of their sin: blatant **idolatry**.
 - The consequence of their sin: rampant immorality.
 - They needed God's deliverance.
 - They needed someone to rescue them from divine <u>judgment</u>.
 - They needed someone to show them divine <u>mercy</u>.
- One God over all Nations...
 - They illustrate man's depravity.
 - Seemingly innumerable **gods**.
 - Seemingly inconceivable practices.
 - They need God's deliverance.
 - Masses are <u>under</u> divine judgment in their sin.
 - Most are <u>unaware of</u> divine mercy in the gospel.
- One God over Us...
 - We illustrate man's depravity.
 - We are often **blind** to our own idolatry.
 - We pass the **blame** for our own immorality.
 - We need God's deliverance.
 - Jesus has **saved** our lives from divine judgment.
 - We must <u>spend</u> our lives proclaiming divine mercy.
