

## PSALM 46

### **God Is Our Refuge and Strength, a Very Present Help in Trouble.**

NOTE: Historical background of Psalm 46 is a bit unclear. There are many that attribute it being written in response to an Assyrians siege of Jerusalem in roughly 700 B.C. found in 2 Kings 18 and 19 & Isaiah 36 and 37)

Proverbs 18:10 - "The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous man runs into it and is safe."

#### **1. In Cosmic Chaos:**
